Corporate Control and Analysis (CCA) Student Organization: The CCA Student Organization aims to help students prepare for careers in the Corporate Accounting, Finance, Advisory, and Consulting industries while promoting the CCA program.

Assistance in Transition to University Park (AT UP): Aids students transitioning from a Penn State University Commonwealth Campus to the University Park Campus. Events include study sessions, professional development, and more.

Penn State Prime: Enables students to practice and improve their skills in branding, media marketing, and marketing analytics through real-world industry projects, case competitions, and workshops

Employer Guidelines

We've updated our **guidelines** & now ask that employers provide a reasonable time frame for acceptance of offers extended to candidates. We suggest that candidates are given at least 10 business days to make a decision on an offer, with a preference of 15 - 25 business days. Please note that specific academic colleges or programs may have additional guidelines. Therefore, we highly recommend that you consult with the appropriate office.
